

Vaishnav Youth Retreat (VYR) Adult Volunteer Handbook 2023

Minimum Qualifications:

- Ability to relate to and work with campers, counselor and all others.
- Ability to accept supervision and guidance.
- Ability to assist in cooking, cleanup, setup etc.
- Willingness to be flexible with assignments.
- Possession of good character, integrity and adaptability.
- Must be disciplined, energetic, adaptive and have patience.

Volunteer Responsibilities:

- Fulfill duties assigned by the Camp Head/s, Kitchen Lead/s, Camp Director/s, etc.
- Must follow the daily schedule.
- Keep the camp premises and property clean.
- Volunteers must report any activities or behaviors which may be deemed inappropriate and/or are not allowed at camp.
- Please DO NOT play any favoritism to any family member or friend at camp.
- Bring up questions or concerns to the Camp Head.
- Positively interact with everyone as needed.
- Enforce camp safety regulations and make sure that camp premises are always safe.
- Promote healthy hygiene, proper etiquette and positive behavior.
- Work as part of a team.

Dress Code:

- Volunteers are expected to dress appropriately for camp. You are required to set an example for counselors and campers.
- Clothing with inappropriate language or messages (implied or stated) is not acceptable.
- Closed toe shoes are preferred. Shoes must be always worn.

Code of Conduct:

- Volunteers are not to deal with campers, counselors, or one another in a degrading or abusive matter. All problems with campers or counselors should be addressed to the Camp Head(s) or Camp Director.
- Volunteers are permitted to carry their cell phones, but they should NOT have them out at any time except for during free time or as needed for camp needs.
- Physical or continual verbal abuse, profanity to any camper, counselor or volunteer will result in the dismissal of the violator.
- VYR Camp is a tobacco, drug, and alcohol-free environment. Possession or use of these substances (including but not limited to cigarettes, e- cigarettes, marijuana, cocaine, beer, wine, etc.) during camp will constitute immediate grounds for dismissal.
- No outside non-vegetarian food is permitted.
- Gambling or card games of any kind that uses chips or any such form of counting mechanism is not allowed.

Volunteer Bedtime Policy:

- Everyone including Volunteers must follow bedtime/lights out rules.
- You must remember being an adult Volunteer, you need be up in the morning earlier than the campers and counselors
